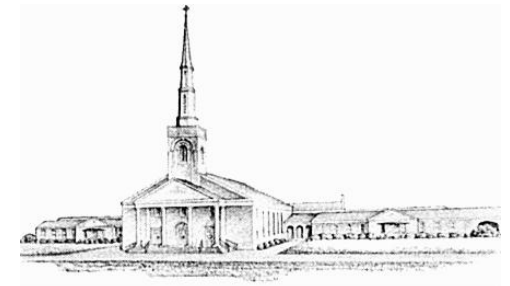
The Northern Border Bluegrass Band
