CALLED CHURCH CONFERENCE – APRIL 11 * AFTER THE MORNING SERVICE

We will consider a recommendation from the Property Committee and the Deacons that the church employ *Bonitz* to replace the flooring in the sanctuary and foyers at a cost of \$74,720.00; that we employ *Premier Pew Padding* to replace the upholstery at a cost of \$27,980.00; and that we employ *B & H Acoustics Inc* to replace the ceilings in the foyers at a cost of \$10,810.00. A display will be set up with samples of the proposed materials. The Property Committee is in the process of receiving bids and hope to be able to present a recommendation soon to replace the lighting in the foyers and the flooring in the office area. Funds for these projects will come from the contributions to our Over and Above Project and from a gift from Michiko Phillips’ Estate.
