Next Sunday we will begin meeting in our Fellowship Hall for our Worship Services while the flooring is replaced in the Church Sanctuary. At our Church Conference last Sunday, the church was asked what time they preferred the Sunday Morning Worship Service to begin. 67% (of those who expressed a preference) selected 10:00 am.

HELP NEEDED AFTER THIS MORNING'S SERVICE

We are organizing teams to help move things after the morning service to get things ready for the flooring work.

- We will be moving Bibles, hymnals, the communion table, sanctuary choir chairs, sound equipment and music instruments to the Fellowship Hall.
- We will be storing the pulpit, pulpit furniture, platform dividers, furniture from the foyers, choir room chairs, furnishings from the choir room and robing rooms in the classrooms connected to the Adult II Department.
- We will be preparing the Builders Room and Adult I to receive pews. (They will be stored there and in Adult II while the work is done on the sanctuary flooring.)
- We will be moving the platforms in the Fellowship Hall choir loft to the classroom beside the Fellowship Hall men's room.
- We will need to assist our sound and media team with moving/storing equipment.
- There are probably other tasks that we will discover as we get started.
