WALKING THROUGH THE BIBLE

Wednesdays * 6:00 pm Fellowship Hall

Join us as we listen for God's voice & as we grow in our understanding. The study is livestreamed on our YouTube channel & can be viewed live a little after 6:00 pm or afterward at a time of your convenience.

August 18 - *Luke* **August 25** – *John*

- John's Gospel contains artistically complex combinations of theological themes yet it is written so simply & powerfully that it is a great starting place for people who are reading the Bible for the first time.
- John emphasizes Jesus' relationship with God as "Father". In Matthew, Mark, & Luke, Jesus refers to God as "Father" a combined total of 64 times. But in John's Gospel alone there are over 120 references.
- John emphasizes Jesus' eternal nature. There are no stories of Jesus' birth. John states that Jesus is God & was with God in the beginning. In John's Gospel, Jesus often speaks of Himself using God's covenant name, "I AM." John includes 7 "I AM Statements" that show His relationship to the Father & to us.
- John does not follow the chronological or geographic outline that the other gospel writers used but instead outlines the events thematically & theologically.
- John includes powerful encounters and stories that do not appear in the other Gospel accounts such as Jesus conversation with Nicodemus and the Woman at the Well, turning water to wine, raising Lazarus from the dead, washing the disciples' feet, the appearance to Thomas, and the recommissioning of Peter. He does not include Jesus' baptism, temptation, transfiguration, or the institution of the Lord's supper.
- John chooses 7 miraculous signs of Jesus. These are not only a demonstration of His power, but signs of Jesus' person and authority. John's Gospel teaches us that in a very real way — "believing is seeing."
- The disciple John is never mentioned, but there are frequent references to "The disciple whom Jesus loved."
- John uses a different vocabulary than the other Gospel writers. He frequently chooses words with a multiple meanings. For example when Jesus says "If I be lifted up I will draw all men to Me." The word for "lifted up" can mean "to exalt." It can also mean "to crucify." John writes in dualistic terms of light and darkness, life and death, truth and falsehood.
- John places Jesus' death at the exact moment that the Passover Lamb would be slain in Jewish households.
- John writes for the express purpose, "that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name." John emphasizes that eternal life begins the moment you put your trust in Jesus.




