August 25 – John September 1 - Acts

- Luke, is the author or the Book of Acts and the Gospel According to Luke.
- Luke and Acts together represent ¹/₄ of the New Testament. Acts is the second longest book of the New Testament. (Luke is the longest.) They tie together Jesus' ministry with the on-going work of the Church.
- Both are written to Theophilus whose name means "lover of God."
- Luke was a doctor (Col. 4:14), who traveled with Paul on parts of his missionary journeys. He is an eyewitness to some of the events recorded in the Book of Acts.
- The Book of Acts ends with an adverb that could be translated "unhinderedly." It tells the story of the unhindered gospel. The message of the gospel overcomes the barriers of geography, language, culture, race, nationality, persecution, and circumstance.
- The events recorded in the book of Acts take place between 30 62 AD.
- The Holy Spirit is mentioned so often in the Book of Acts (over 50 times) that many consider the book to be "The Acts of the Holy Spirit."
- Acts contains portions of 24 speeches and sermons. The sermons give us the most detailed review of Old Testament events in the New Testament.
- Acts gives an account of the beginning of many of the churches that are later addressed in Paul's letters.
- Acts contains beautiful prayers and helps us to understand the essential role of prayer in the churches.
- Luke includes precise historical details that have been confirmed by archaeological findings.
- Major themes in the Book of Acts include: World Mission, the Providence of God, the Power of the Holy Spirit, the Inclusive Gospel, Faithful Witnesses, the Relationship of Christians to Society, and the Triumph of the Gospel.

WOODRUFF AREA SOUP KITCHEN


