WALKING THROUGH THE BIBLE

Wednesdays * 6:00 pm Fellowship Hall

This week we begin a fresh study of the New Testament. Join us as we listen for God's voice & as we grow in our understanding. The study is livestreamed on our YouTube channel & can be viewed live a little after 6:00 pm or afterward at a time of your convenience.

August 4 – *Matthew* **August 11** – *Mark*

Mark's Gospel is the shortest and the earliest Gospel. It is written in a fast paced style. The word "immediately" appears over 40 times. Mark includes more "miracle stories" than any other writer. He emphasizes Jesus' actions.

Early Church Father's considered Mark's Gospel to be the "memoirs" of Peter. Mark is mentioned by Paul (2 Timothy 4:11) and Peter (1 Peter 5:13) in their last writings.

Mark was a teenager during Jesus' ministry. The church met at his mother Mary's house. Mark was a cousin to Barnabas & was part of Paul's first missionary journey. Mark & Barnabas later embarked on another missionary journey. Mark is also called John Mark.

The opening verse of Mark is where we get the name "Gospel" which means, "Good News" and is used to refer to the first four books of the New Testament as well as God's redemptive work in salvation.

Mark masterfully writes of Jesus who is the "Son of God." He tells us that in the first verse, and reminds us through the voice of God and of demons, but does not have a human voice confess this until a climatic point when the centurion confesses at the foot of Jesus' cross.

The first part of Mark's gospel focuses on Jesus' identity. We walk with the disciples as they discover very gradually that Jesus is God. They see Jesus forgive sins and accept worship and repeatedly demonstrate His power over nature, matter, the demonic, sickness, and even death itself.

Mark's gospel is arranged geographically. He tells us of Jesus' ministry in Galilee, then of the journey toward and events in Jerusalem.

Mark places a strong emphasis on Jesus' humanity, the importance of faith, the cost of discipleship, and the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

Mark points out that Jesus' disciples were slow to understand. Each time Jesus tells them of His death and resurrection they are distracted by their own arguments.

Mark is famous for telling stories in "sandwich" fashion. He will begin a story, then tell a second story, and then complete the first story. Through this we see that the gospel is true to life.




