# **2022 CONTRIBUTION ENVELOPES**

We are grateful for your gifts to the Lord's church. We pray that the Lord will continue to bless and multiply them as we seek to be faithful to the mission He has entrusted to us here in Woodruff and beyond. We believe strongly that God still has a plan and a purpose for this church even in the difficult times in which we live.

Packets of contributions envelopes have been prepared for those who requested them last year and are available in your Sunday School class or if you wanted them mailed you should receive them soon. Please contact us if you haven't been receiving envelope packets but would like to start.

Here are some of the ways that people give their tithes and offerings to our church.

**Bank draft** – You can set up a draft from your bank that is sent to the church. This can be done for each gift or you can set up an automatic draft each month. Most banks offer this as a free service to their customers, which means there is no cost to you or to the church.

**Offering boxes / Mailed in Offering** – During the pandemic we stopped passing the offering plates in the worship service, but offering boxes have been installed at each door of the sanctuary (and in the hallway outside the kitchen.) Envelopes are available in the entryways & pews for you to use while you are here & are also available for you to take home with you for future gifts. We also receive tithes & offerings through the mail.

**Online giving** – Our church website has a tab for online giving (<u>www.fbcwoodruff.org.</u>) You can set up an individual gift or recurring gifts. Companies that provide this kind of service pass along a transaction fee to the church that is a percentage of your gift. The percentage varies depending on what type of bank card is used. The lowest percentage is used when you enter your banking information (routing and account number) rather than using a credit or debit card. There is an option for you to include this transaction fee in your gift.

#### Dec. 1 – 2 Timothy Dec. 8 – Titus

It is thought that Paul wrote *Titus* between 62-64 AD around the same time he wrote *1 Timothy* (between his first and second Roman imprisonment.) Paul is writing from either Corinth or Nicopolis (3:12) to Titus whom Paul left to serve in Crete (1:5.) Paul is sending Atremas or Tychicus to Crete and wants Titus to join him in Nicopolis for the winter.

Paul refers to Titus as his "true son in the faith" (1:4): his "brother" (2 Cor. 2:13) and as his "partner" & "coworker" (2 Cor. 8:23.) Titus accompanied Paul from Antioch to Jerusalem to a meeting of church leaders. Even though He was Greek they did not compel him to be circumcised. (Galatians 2:1-3.) Paul points this out to emphasize that a person did not need to become Jewish before they could become a Christian. Titus (who is mentioned 9 times in 2 Corinthians) was sent on mission by Paul to Corinth and helped collect their love offering for the Jerusalem Church. Near the end of Paul's life, he mentions that Titus has gone to Dalmatia (2 Timothy 4:10.) Some traditions state that Titus was martyred in Dalmatia around the same time as Paul's execution. Other traditions have him returning to Crete and dying peacefully after a lifetime of service.

Through his words of encouragement, Paul seeks to help Titus equip the churches at Crete to be effective in sharing the message of salvation. This involves getting rid of false teachers, appointing and discipling good leaders, and strengthening people in each age group so that their lives "will make the teaching about God our Savior attractive." (2:10) The incredible grace believers experience through God's saving work equips them to live very differently than the way they lived before and this creates a powerful way for the message of salvation to be proclaimed. "At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another. But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared. He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of His **mercy.**" (3:3-5)

#### BACKPACK DISTRIBUTION MISSION TRIP


