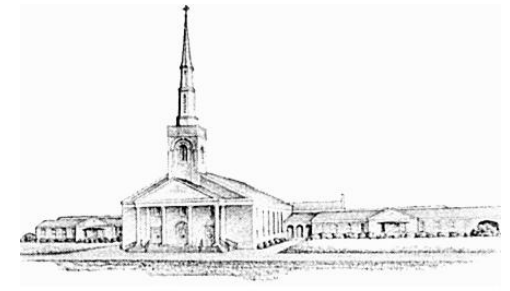
SNOW TEAM
