

WALKING THROUGH THE BIBLE Wednesdays * 6:00 pm * Fellowship Hall

The Gospel of John, 1, 2 & 3 John and Revelation were written by the disciple John, the son of Zebedee, brother of James. Polycarp (70-160 AD) an early church leader, testified (recorded by Irenaeus) that John wrote the gospel during his residence at Ephesus when he was advanced in age. 1, 2 & 3 John appear to have been written after the Gospel of John. Revelation was written last of all, while John was exiled on the island of Patmos (c. 95 AD) during the Domitian persecution of Christians.

2 & 3 John are the shortest books of the Bible, each containing less than 250 Greek words. Each letter could fit on a single papyrus sheet. In each letter he tells them that he has much to write to them but would prefer to speak to them face to face.

2 John is addressed to "the lady chosen by God and to her children, whom I love in the truth - and not I only, but also all who know the truth" and is thought to be a letter to a specific house church. John, "the elder" emphasizes adherence to the truth v. 4, love v. 5, and obedience, v. 6. He warns them not to aid false teachers who were deceiving people by saying that Jesus was not a human being of flesh and bone.

3 John is addressed to "my dear friend Gaius, whom I love in the truth." Nothing is known to us about Gaius outside of John's letter. "Gaius" was a very common name in the first century. John writes to commend Gaius for the hospitality he has shown to those who are true ministers of the Gospel. He is concerned about Diotephes who speaks maliciously about John, refuses to welcome other believers and puts people out of the church who do welcome them. John commends Demetrius who is well spoken of by everyone - and even the truth itself. "Dear friend, do not imitate what is evil but what is good. Anyone who does what is good is from God. Anyone who does what is evil has not seen God." v. 11.


