- Paul helped form the Church at Ephesus and served there for almost 3 years during his 3rd Missionary Journey (Acts 18:19 - 20:1.)
- Ephesians is short only 155 verses (6 chapters) leading scholars to say that "Pound for pound, Ephesians may well be the most influential document in history."
- Ephesians deepens our understanding of the gospel and salvation; celebrates the incredible spiritual blessings we have in Christ; clearly communicates that we are saved by grace through faith; helps us to see the importance of the Church; emphasizes the unity that comes through Christ; gives practical instruction for marriage, parenting, vocation and living the Christian life; helps us become equipped for spiritual warfare; and contains beautiful prayers that glorify God and help us as we worship God.


