February 24 – Proverbs * March 3 – Ecclesiastes Written by King Solomon who ruled the United Kingdoms of Israel and Judah from 971 to 931 BC, Ecclesiastes is an honest exploration of some of life's most difficult questions. Solomon was blessed with wisdom, wealth and power, but he found them all to be unsatisfying. After exploring them fully, he determines that ultimate meaning and fulfillment do not come through wisdom, pleasure, work, wealth or achievement. In fact, he concludes they are meaningless. The Hebrew word translated "vanity," "futile," "meaningless," and "pointless" occurs 37 times. He views death as a great enemy that robs life of satisfaction and because of that urges us not to wait to know our Creator and experience the fleeting joys of life. He teaches us that time and eternity are precious gifts of God. In many, many ways Ecclesiastes shows us our need for Jesus - for true fulfillment is found only in Him. Through His resurrection, Jesus transforms the enemy death into a doorway to victory and one day will destroy death entirely. The frustrations expressed in Ecclesiastes help prepare us for the abundant and eternal life that can come through Jesus Christ our Lord.


