Tell Us More About THE BOOK OF DANIEL

— The Book of Daniel contains fascinating verses of Scripture, stories that stick in our memory, and powerful words of prophecy.

- The stories in the Book of Daniel take place between 605 and 535 BC with prophecies that extend far into the future.
- Because the detailed prophecies about future events are fulfilled with incredible accuracy many people conclude that they must have been written after the predicted events took place, but the archeological and historical evidence confirms that these prophecies were recorded long before the predicted events. The Book of Daniel provides overwhelming evidence of a supernatural God.
- In addition to the archeological and historical evidence relating to the dating of the Book of Daniel we have Jesus our Lord's confirmation that Daniel is a true prophet of God. (Matthew 24:15)
- The Book of Daniel contains powerful descriptions of Jesus. He is described as: a Rock not cut by human hands that topples world empires and becomes a mountain that covers the whole earth a Kingdom that will never be destroyed. (Daniel 2) He is the fourth man in the fiery furnace. (Daniel 3) He is the "Son of Man" who was "given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped Him. His Dominion is an everlasting Dominion that will not pass away, and His Kingdom is one that will never be destroyed." (Daniel 7) He is the "Anointed One," who will be put to death after 62 'sevens.' (Daniel 9)
- God's revelation in Nebuchadnezzar's dream (Daniel 2) accurately foretells the world empires that follow Babylon. Remembering the statue from the vision helps us to remember the historical context of books during and after the Babylonian Exile as well as some of the ways God used these empires to prepare the way for the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Babylon – *Jeremiah*, *Daniel*, *Ezekiel*, *Lamentations*, some *Psalms*. Babylon was raised up as an instrument of God's judgement and provides a setting for Israel's faith to be refined.

Persia – *Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi*. Persia allows and funds the return to the land and the rebuilding of the Temple.

Greece – The time between the OT and NT when the books of the *Apocrypha* are written including *1 & 2 Maccabees*. Greece provides a universal language through which the Gospel is communicated.

Rome – *The New Testament*. Rome provides roads & safer travel for the Gospel to be spread. It also becomes an instrument of God's judgment.




