Reflection THE VICTORY OF GRACE

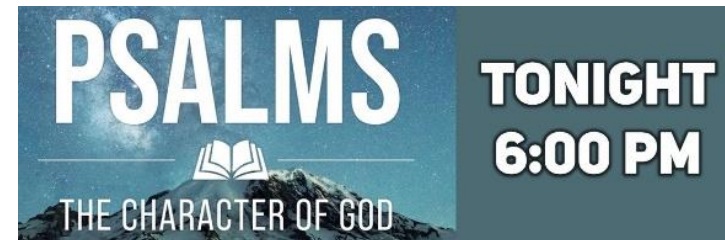
When we've been there ten thousand years, bright shining as the sun!
