**Thro' death into life everlasting He passed and we follow Him there;**

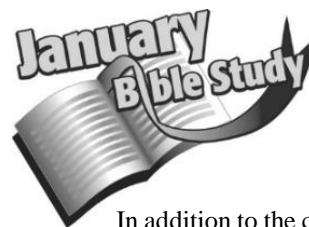
**Over us sin no more hath dominion for more than conq'rors we are!**
