# NEW MAILED ENVELOPE SYSTEM

We are grateful for your gifts to the Lord's church. We pray that the Lord will continue to bless and multiply them as we seek to be faithful to the mission He has entrusted to us here in Woodruff and beyond. We believe strongly that God still has a plan and a purpose for this church even in the difficult times in which we live.

Our world continues to change and so does the way that people give their tithes and offerings. Because we want to be good stewards of the resources God's people entrust to His church we are in the process of evaluating the way we distribute contribution envelopes. Envelopes have already been mailed out that will go through January 31, 2021. We want to make a plan for February, 2021 and beyond. Here are some of the ways that people give their tithes and offerings to our church.

Bank draft – You can set up a draft from your bank that is sent to the church. This can be done for each gift or you can set up an automatic draft each month. Most banks offer this as a free service to their customers, which means there is no cost to you or to the church.

Offering plate / Mailed in Offering – During the pandemic we stopped passing the offering plates in the worship service, but they are still available at each door of the sanctuary. Envelopes are available in the entryways & pews for you to use while you are here & are also available for you to take home with you for future gifts. We also receive tithes & offerings through the mail.

Online giving – Our church website has a tab for online giving (<a href="www.fbcwoodruff.org">www.fbcwoodruff.org</a>.) You can set up an individual gift or recurring gifts. Companies that provide this kind of service pass along a transaction fee to the church that is a percentage of your gift. The percentage varies depending on what type of bank card is used. The lowest percentage is used when you enter your banking information (routing and account number) rather than using a credit or debit card. There is an option for you to include this transaction fee in your gift.

## ENTRUST YOURSELF TO JESUS

Paul wrote, "I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances." He goes on to say... "I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do everything through Him who gives me strength." Philippians 4:11-13

Philippians is an incredible letter. Paul is in prison. He is uncertain if he will be pardoned or executed. Yet, the letter is filled with powerful expressions of joy & contentment, relying on God regardless of the circumstances. This is more than just trying to make good out of a bad situation. This is more than life handing us lemons & us trying to make lemonade. This is a reliance & trust in God that brings true joy & contentment - joy & contentment that rises above the circumstances. It is to entrust yourself to God - confident that He is at work for your good even in the worst of circumstances.

Robert Louis Stevenson's grandfather was at sea when a terrible storm took place. Huge waves threatened to swamp the ship. When the danger was the greatest and the storm was the fiercest, Stevenson's grandfather carefully walked up on the deck to see how bad things really were. What he discovered brought him immense comfort. There was the captain of the ship lashed with ropes to the wheel, holding the vessel off the rocks, and carefully steering it to safer waters. The captain looked up and smiled, and that smile reassured the frightened passenger. Going back to the cabin, he said "We shall come through; I saw the captain smile!"

God our Captain is at the wheel! He is sovereign! He has His hand on us, and on the wheel. We don't have to worry or be afraid. Like Paul we can be content, not because everything is going well, but because we have learned to rely on God's goodness, greatness, and His incredible love.

Following Jesus requires entrusting ourselves to Him. It is an eternal commitment. Every day we are tempted to trust in ourselves rather than entrusting ourselves to Jesus. But if we learn to trust Him, we have no true cause for worry or for fear.




