THE WAY OF THE DISCIPLE: TAKE UP THE CROSS Luke 9:22-26

Embrace the Cross

# v. 22 And He said, "The Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and He must be killed and on the third day be raised to life."

**"Son of Man"** – Jesus has been given authority, glory and sovereign power and will be worshipped by all nations and people of every language. His Kingdom will never end – see Daniel 7:13-14. Jesus is the true King we must obey and follow.

**"Must"** – There is no other way of salvation. Jesus is the only one in all the universe who is perfect and is fully God and fully man.

Precision – Jesus tells us exactly what is about to happen so that when it does happen we will understand more fully who He is and what He came to do.

"Rejected" - Our sinful pride leads us away from God.

**"Suffer," "Be Killed"** – He pays the price we owe. He is pierced for us. It is by His wounds that we are healed - See Isaiah 53.

**"Be Raised"** – Jesus will conqueror sin and death. Because He lives we can live.

# v. 23 Then He said to them all: "Whoever wants to be My disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me."

**"Whoever wants to be My disciple"** – A required, essential, non-negotiable commitment.

**"Deny Themselves"** – To put aside selfishness. To live a God-centered life.

**"Take Up Their Cross Daily"** – To live sacrificially – being willing to do unpleasant and difficult things – to risk your life and livelihood for Christ.

"Follow Me" – to obey Christ, following His example – having the same attitude.

# v. 24 "For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for Me will save it."

Self-centeredness robs us of what is truly important in life and eternity.

Christ-centeredness leads to peace, joy, fulfillment and love in this life and the life to come. We are called to be faithful even unto death.

# v. 25 "What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, and yet lose or forfeit their very self?"

This world can only give temporary pleasure. Don't lose sight of eternity.

# v. 26 "Whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when He comes in His glory and in the glory of the Father and of the holy angels."

Follow Jesus at all costs. He bore our shame. Stand with the Truth.
