- 1. ___ Jeremiah's ministry took place during the 40 years before and during the fall of the nation of Judah and the destruction of the Temple and the city of Jerusalem by the Babylonians.
- 2. ___ Fortunately the nation of Judah learned to love and obey God after watching their sister country Israel fall to the Assyrians.
- 3. God tells Jeremiah that before He formed him in the womb He knew him, set him apart, and appointed him a prophet to the nations.
- 4. ___ Once Jeremiah warned the people with prophesies from God, they turned from their wicked ways.
- 5. Jeremiah described God's messages as a "fire in his bones," so powerful that he could not help but share them.
- 6. ___ Jeremiah is known as the "weeping prophet."
- 7. ___ If you count the number of Hebrew words, Jeremiah is the longest book of the Bible.
- 8. ___ Jeremiah records God saying that even during the reforms and spiritual revival led by King Josiah that the people did not return to Him with all their heart but only in pretense.

- 11. ____While the book of Jeremiah contains many words of warning and righteous judgement, it also contains a powerful message of hope and a future from God who is constantly at work to bring redemption and salvation.
- 12. ___The book of Jeremiah ends by telling us that Jehoiachin, an ancestor of Jesus, was allowed to put aside his prison clothes and for the rest of his life ate regularly at the king of Babylon's table.
