And so it should come as no surprise to us that 43% of the Bible is presented in story form. Join us this Sunday as we learn some fascinating things about the way design patterns, plots, character development, and settings are used in the Bible. Our study will include videos produced by The Bible Project, a time of discussion, application and challenge. The goal of the study is to equip us with a greater appreciation for the beautiful way God is at work, help enhance our reading of the Scriptures, and allow us see how each part connects to the unified message.

#### **ZECHARIAH: THE LORD REMEMBERS** A Verse by Verse Bible Study

The name "Zechariah" means, "The LORD remembers." His father's name "Berekiah" means, "The LORD blesses." His grandfather's name "Iddo" means, "In time." A powerful theme running through the book of Zechariah is that "The Lord remembers and blesses His people in His time." The setting for the poetry, prose and apocalyptic visions is the time of rebuilding after the Babylonian exile. While many Christians are unfamiliar with the book of Zechariah, it was very familiar to the writers of the New Testament. It is quoted or alluded to 71 times in the New Testament. It contains more messianic references than any prophetic book except Isaiah. Each section addresses the people of Zechariah's own time & then moves ahead to the time of the Messiah & the future Messianic Kingdom. Plan to be with us as we dive deeply into God's word.


