July 14 – Zechariah July 21 – Malachi

The name "Malachi" means "The Lord's Messenger." It is written around 450 BC, after the Babylonian exile and during the time of Persian control of Judah. 80 to 100 years before the Book of Malachi, a small remnant of the Jewish people have returned to Jerusalem. The Temple has been rebuilt 516 BC, and the walls were being completed (between 458 and 430 BC.) Malachi is written after the events in the book of Ezra and during or shortly after the events recording in the book of Nehemiah, but not during Nehemiah's two terms as Governor. It is 55 verses long. Of the 55 verses, 47 quote the voice of God. There are no less than 27 questions in the book. It presents a question and answer style of preaching that became a very popular format in later Judaism. Malachi states in the opening verse that it is an "oracle" or "prophecy" literarily a "burden" indicating that it is a heavy message containing stern warnings. God begins by emphatically stating His love and then challenges the motives and actions of His people who have betrayed His love. Malachi addresses the same complacency and disregard for God that are present among God's people today. The people were discouraged by hard economic realities and Persian dominance. Some felt the Lord did not really love them because of these factors. They brought defective animals for sacrifice, worship was a drudgery and many felt that serving God a waste of time. Although the people blamed God, their plight was the result of their own sinfulness: contempt for God, corrupt priests, marriage to pagans, failure to tithe, not keeping the Sabbath, marital unfaithfulness, mistreatment of the weak, and perjury. Malachi challenges the people to return to God - "Return to Me and I will return to you." 3:7 The Book of Malachi is repeatedly quoted and alluded to in the New Testament - Matthew 11:10; 17:12; Mark 1:2; 9:11-12; Luke 1:17; Romans 9:13. Malachi seeks to prepare the people for the coming of the Messiah and the Messenger who will proceed Him. 3:1-5; 17-18; 4:1-3; 5-6. This Messenger will seek to "turn the hearts of the parents to their children and the hearts of children to their parents." 4:6
