INVEST YOURSELF IN GOD'S WORD

It was reading the Gospel of John that first caused me (Andrew) to fall in love with the Bible. I had grown up in church, grown up reading the Scriptures, but as a young adult I realized - and it was as if a light bulb came on – how incredibly complex and beautiful the Scriptures had been written. I thought I knew the Bible pretty well, but I began to discover layer upon layer upon layer of meaning in what appeared to be a simple text.

Some people discover the greatness of God by looking through a telescope – seeing the vastness of the universe, the beauty, order, and complexity of heavens, more precise than any clock. Some people discover the greatness of God by looking through a microscope – worlds, within worlds, beautiful order, intricate function and design. For me... It was the Gospel of John – so beautiful, so simple, yet complex. It is so life changing and powerful - pointing me to a God who is so far above my understanding, yet who reaches down into the depths of my heart. It was reading the Gospel of John that first caused me to fall in love with the Bible which gave me a greater and deeper love for God.

There are many things about the Gospel of John that grab your attention. Here are a few of them...

- † 7 miraculous signs so that we will believe and have life.
- † 7 "I AM" statements that reveal who Jesus is and who we are in relation to Him and the Father.
- † A series of words with double meanings, where both meanings are intended.
- † Powerful conversations with Jesus, sermons and stories that are only found in John's Gospel.
- † Mysteries like "Who is the Beloved Disciple?"

The wonders of John's gospel opened my mind and heart to the wonders that are found in each book of the Bible. God's eternal perspective and handiwork is everywhere to be seen. Like the ocean, the Bible has places where preschoolers can learn and play and yet it also has incredible depths that few human eyes have seen. It is life changing, and new and fresh every morning. Invest yourself in the study of God's word!




