Those who are currently serving and those who are rotating off as deacons are not eligible for election.

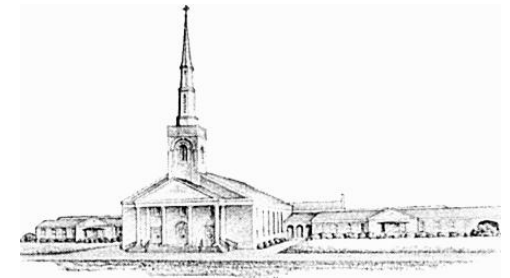

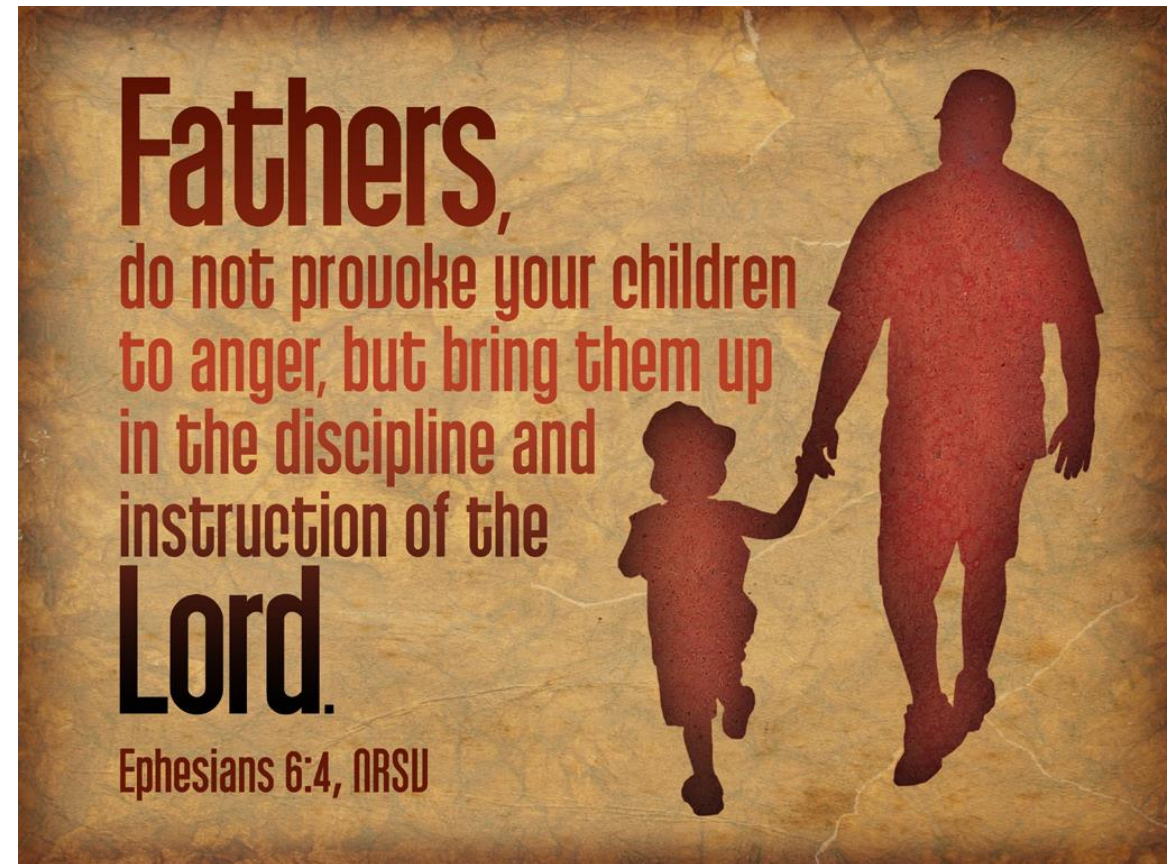
