FATHER'S DAY TRUTHS

1. GOD ESTABLISHED THE HOME.

As He created us, God, Himself, established the home, the family. **So God created mankind in His own image, in the image of God He created them; male and female He created them. Genesis 1:27**

The Bible teaches that marriage is to be a permanent relationship of one man and one woman freely and totally committed to each other as companions for life. As Jesus was answering the Pharisee's question... **"Haven't you read," He replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh'? So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate."** **Matthew 19:4-6**

The home, the family, is the very basis of our society. Abraham Lincoln reminded us that *"The strength of a nation lies in the homes of its people."* As the family goes... so goes the nation. And God has given fathers the incredible responsibility of caring for their families.

2. GOD ESTABLISHED WHEN AND WHERE WE WOULD LIVE SO THAT WE WOULD SEEK HIM.

From one man He made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and He marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands. God did this so that they would seek Him and perhaps reach out for Him and find Him, though He is not far from any one of us. Acts 17:26-27

We are not here by accident. God has set the appointed times and places. He is at work... so that we will seek Him, so that we will reach out to Him, so that we would find Him. This is God's purpose in setting the places and times for us to live.

3. GOD IS THE GOOD FATHER.

"Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in Heaven give good gifts to those who ask Him!" **Matthew 7:9-11**

God is present and involved. He know and He cares. He knows every hair on our heads and about every worry we have. He is not distant from us - in fact He is never absent from any event in our lives. We have no problems or burdens that He is unwilling to share. He is with us in times of great joy. In times of sorrow, He not only knows our pain

and struggles, He feels them even more deeply than we do because of His love for us. He doesn't give up on us. He is patient. He doesn't disown us, He doesn't turn His back on us.

God provides. He gives good gifts to His children. Everything that is truly good in our lives comes from God. We can depend on Him. God is faithful. He keeps His promises.

He disciplines us. He loves us just as we are but loves us too much to leave us that way. **"I discipline those I love."** **Revelation 3:19** Like a potter, He shapes and molds us, helping us reach our potential. Like a gardener, He prunes each branch to make it even more fruitful. Like a coach, He trains us and prepares us. Like a Father, He disciplines us, so that we can experience life that is truly life.

He wants us to share in His work. In creation, He gave mankind the responsibility of caring for the earth. As Christ-followers, He gives us the incredible task of bringing people back to Him. He entrusts us with wonderful gifts that we can use for His glory. He is the Good Father.

4. GOD ENTRUSTS FATHERS WITH THE SPIRITUAL CARE AND INSTRUCTION OF THEIR FAMILIES.

Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord. Ephesians 6:4

Lead your children to know how much God loves them. Help them discover and put to use the gifts that God has entrusted to them. Make it possible for them to grow in the knowledge of God's word – for everyday there can be fresh discoveries. Lead them in times of worship as a family. Model for them what it means to love and trust God. Use some of the time you have together to talk about the ways God is at work and the things that you are discovering in your own walk with Christ. **Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Deuteronomy 6:5-7**

A POSTCARD FROM TAIWAN

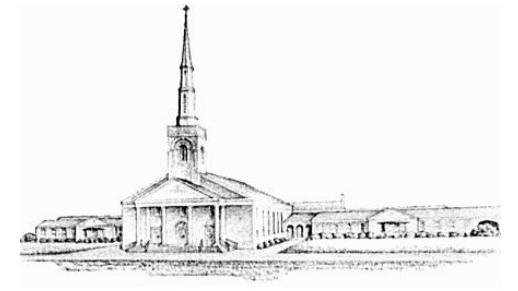
Dear Woodruff 1st Baptist Church Family,
