THE PRODIGAL FATHER  
Luke 15:11-32

**prod·i·gal**

- (adjective) 1. Spending money or resources freely and recklessly; wastefully extravagant.  
2. Having or giving something on a lavish scale.  
(noun) – A person who spends money in a recklessly extravagant way.

**“There was a man who had two sons...” v. 11**

Both sons have traveled far away from their father in their \_\_\_\_\_.

The younger son's demand is far \_\_\_\_\_ than we thought.

Jesus' audience would be \_\_\_\_\_ to hear that the father granted the son's demand.

**“So he divided his *bion* between them.” v. 12**

{Bios – life, livelihood, living}

The son \_\_\_\_\_ everything before he comes to his senses.

The son takes an important step as he starts toward home, but notice that he is still more interested in his father's \_\_\_\_\_ than he is in his father.

In contrast, notice the father's \_\_\_\_\_ love.

The father is watching for him, is filled with compassion for him, runs to him, embraces and kisses him. The father is as \_\_\_\_\_ in his love and acceptance as the son was in humiliating his father.

Robe – \_\_\_\_\_  
Ring – \_\_\_\_\_  
Shoes – \_\_\_\_\_  
Fatted Calf – \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_ the father's joy!

The other son is angry, offended, bitter, discontent, disrespectful, self-righteous, critical, selfish and feels \_\_\_\_\_ to what he thinks he has “earned.”

The father \_\_\_\_\_ to him as well – **“everything I have is yours.” v. 31**

Both sons were \_\_\_\_\_ to the father.

- Both sons \_\_\_\_\_ their father's authority and sought ways to getting out from under it.
- Both were \_\_\_\_\_ the father for their own self-centered ends rather than loving, enjoying and serving him for his own sake.
- Neither son had their father's \_\_\_\_\_ as their goal.
- Both in their \_\_\_\_\_, do all that they can to hurt and resist their father.

Like the father, God goes to \_\_\_\_\_ to expresses His love for you. He invites you to live in His life (and enjoy the feast.) God's grace is truly extravagant.

Repentance is more than turning from a list of wrongs. It is turning from a rebellious heart and turning to a heart that truly \_\_\_\_\_ God. We move past a desire for the Father's things and instead desire the Father.

Our Savior Jesus left the \_\_\_\_\_ of home and gave His life that we might be able to know, love and find our home with the Father.
