March 3 – Ecclesiastes * March 10 – Song of Solomon Written by King Solomon who ruled the United Kingdoms of Israel and Judah from 971 to 931 BC, Song of Solomon is an ancient love song that exalts the purity of affection and romance between a husband and a wife. The song tells us of their days of courtship, the early days of their marriage and the maturing of this couple through the ups and downs of life. Its Hebrew metaphors are filled with meaning but sound strange to our ears. They are not intended to be primarily visual. The garden imagery reminds us of the Garden of Eden where a man and woman were naked and vulnerable, yet united and safe. It captures the human longing to know and be known. Love is incredibly powerful. It is a transcendent and mysterious gift from God. "Place me like a seal over your heart, like a seal on your arm; for love is as strong as death, its jealousy unvielding as the grave. It burns like blazing fire, like a mighty flame. Many waters cannot quench love; rivers cannot sweep it away." Song of Solomon 8:6-7


