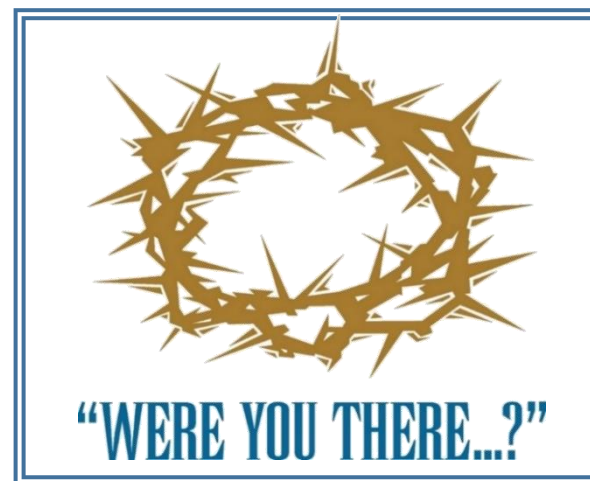
DONATE USED VEHICLES
