MEMORIAL DAY FLAGS



WALKING THROUGH THE BIBLE

Wednesdays * 6:00 pm Fellowship Hall

Join us for Bible study. We live stream the study for those who are not able to be with us in person. It can be viewed live a little after 6:00 pm on Wednesdays or afterward at a time of your convenience. (Once we add Jonah, we will have a video on YouTube for the first 32 books of the Old Testament with 7 more to go.)

May 19 – *Jonah* * **May 26** – *Micah*

The opening verse of Micah tells us that the LORD came to Micah during the reigns of Jotham (750-731 BC), Ahaz (731-715 BC), and Hezekiah (715-686 BC). Micah is a contemporary of Hosea and Isaiah. He lived in Moresheth a town in the foothills of Judah, about 25 miles southwest of Jerusalem. The Book of Micah presents God's "lawsuit" against His people. He indicts Samaria and Jerusalem for their sins – idolatry, seizure of property, failure of civil & religious leadership, offering sacrifices without true repentance, corrupt business practices and violence. God will carry out His righteous judgment through Assyria and Babylon. He will preserve a remnant of His people which will be shepherded by a Ruler who is to come. This Ruler will be born in Bethlehem. In Matthew's gospel, when the Wise Men come to Jerusalem, Herod asks the religious leaders where the Messiah will be born. They tell him, "Bethlehem" and quote from Micah 5:2. When the prophet Jeremiah was about to be sentenced to death for prophesying against Jerusalem, he is saved when some of the elders quote. Micah 3:12, which also predicts the destruction of Jerusalem. Micah gives a clear expression of what God asks of us... "And what does the LORD require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your **God."** Micah 6:8 Jesus quotes from Micah 7:6 when He is teaching about the cost of discipleship (Matthew 10:35-36). The Book of Micah ends with a play on words regarding Micah's name. "Micah" means "Who is like the LORD?" "Who is a God like You who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of His inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy. You will again have compassion on us: You will tread our sins underfoot and hurl all our iniquities into the depths of the sea." Micah 7:18-19


