We are delighted to have Rev. George McDowell, who serves as pastor of the First Baptist Church of Switzer and his son, Rev. Richard McDowell leading our Bible study on June 2. Their presentation will be in the form of a dialogue. Join us for this special Bible Study.

On June 9 we will study the book of Nahum. "Nahum" is a shortened form of the name "Nehemiah" which means "comfort" or "consolation." Nahum was written sometime between 663 and 626 BC. The Book of Nahum is a prophecy against Nineveh. Nineveh, the capital of the Assyrian Empire, had become the largest city in the world. It was a city of great violence and idolatry. God had spared Nineveh because of their repentance during the time of Jonah (c. 760 BC) but the generations that followed had returned with enthusiasm to their old ways. The Assyrian Empire destroyed the capital of Israel, Samaria, (722 BC) and had scattered the 10 northern tribes across the Assyrian Empire and repopulated the area with other conquered peoples. Nahum gives a detailed prophecy about the destruction of Nineveh. His prophecy was perfectly fulfilled in 612 BC when the Babylonians and Medes reduced the city to rubble. The Tigris River overflowed and destroyed enough of the Nineveh's walls to let the invading armies into the city. The Book of Nahum reminds us that "The LORD is slow to anger but great in power; the LORD will not leave the guilty unpunished." **Nahum 1:3** God's power is far, far, greater than that of any army, city or empire.


