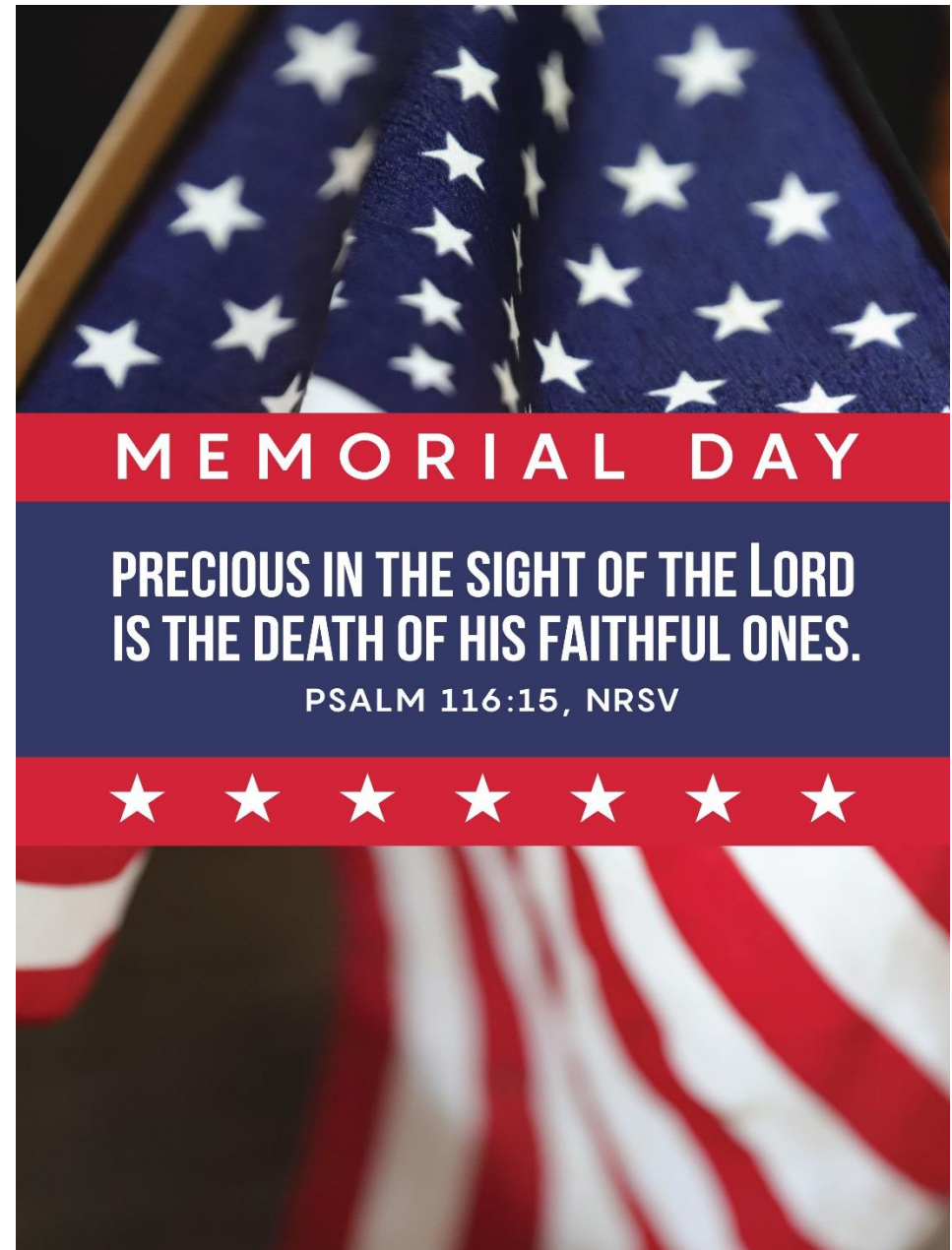

Jesus guide me through the tempest; keep my spirit staid and sure.

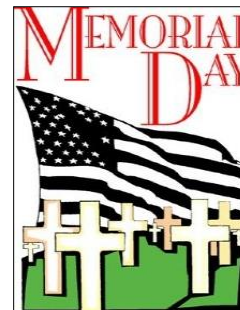
When the midnight meets the morning, let me love You even more.
