May 5 – Amos * May 12 – Obadiah

Obadiah is the shortest book in the Old Testament. Little is known about the prophet Obadiah or the historical context of his prophecy. "Obadiah" means "servant of the LORD." There are at least 20 other individuals with that name in the Old Testament. We know that Obadiah was written shortly after an Edomite assault on Jerusalem that is described in verses 10-14 but we are unsure when that specific assault took place. Obadiah 1-9; Amos 9:11-12 and Jeremiah 49:7-22 address common themes. The relationship between Jacob and Esau (Genesis 25:22-23) and the resulting nations -Israel/Judah and Edom is complicated and it intertwines through most of biblical history. Malachi 1:2 contrasts their relationship to emphasize God's great love for Judah and His rejection of Edom. Paul quotes this passage in Romans 9:13 to emphasis God's mercy and His sovereign choice. Obadiah speaks of the judgment God will bring upon Edom for her pride and for her participation against Judah. A second theme is Judah's restoration that will include territory formerly held by Edom. Ultimate restoration comes through our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.




