WALKING THROUGH THE BIBLE

Wednesdays, Nov. 11 & 18 * 6:00 – 6:45 pm

Join us as we walk through each book of the Bible. On Nov. 11 we will study I Samuel & on Nov. 18 – 2 Samuel. We are spreading out in the Fellowship Hall practicing social distancing. We are posting each study on our church YouTube channel. Take part in the study of God's word.

2 Samuel begins where 1 Samuel ends (they were originally one book) as David hears the news of the death of King Saul (1011 BC.) The book covers the forty years of King David's reign and ends in the later years of David's life just before his death (which is recorded in 1 Kings 2:10.) The stories illustrate the devastating effects of sin and the amazing grace of God. 1 & 2 Samuel provide the background for many of the David's psalms which prepare us for the coming Messiah. God promises David that through his descendants, his house, kingdom and throne would endure forever. This promise is fulfilled through Jesus Christ. God's heart is revealed to David as he continues to love his son, Absalom, who has become his enemy, just as God loves us even when we were His enemies.


