2022 CONTRIBUTION ENVELOPES

We are grateful for your gifts to the Lord's church. We pray that the Lord will continue to bless and multiply them as we seek to be faithful to the mission He has entrusted to us here in Woodruff and beyond. We believe strongly that God still has a plan and a purpose for this church even in the difficult times in which we live.

Packets of contributions envelopes have been prepared for those who requested them last year and are available in your Sunday School class or if you wanted them mailed you should receive them soon. Please contact us if you haven't been receiving envelope packets but would like to start.

Here are some of the ways that people give their tithes and offerings to our church.

Bank draft – You can set up a draft from your bank that is sent to the church. This can be done for each gift or you can set up an automatic draft each month. Most banks offer this as a free service to their customers, which means there is no cost to you or to the church.

Offering boxes / Mailed in Offering – During the pandemic we stopped passing the offering plates in the worship service, but offering boxes have been installed at each door of the sanctuary (and in the hallway outside the kitchen.) Envelopes are available in the entryways & pews for you to use while you are here & are also available for you to take home with you for future gifts. We also receive tithes & offerings through the mail.

Online giving – Our church website has a tab for online giving (www.fbcwoodruff.org.) You can set up an individual gift or recurring gifts. Companies that provide this kind of service pass along a transaction fee to the church that is a percentage of your gift. The percentage varies depending on what type of bank card is used. The lowest percentage is used when you enter your banking information (routing and account number) rather than using a credit or debit card. There is an option for you to include this transaction fee in your gift.

OPERATION: CHRISTMAS CHILD SHOEBOX REPORT

Thanks to everyone who was involved in providing Christmas gifts for needy children. We served as a relay station for the Woodruff Community and collected 1,115 shoeboxes. Pray that God will use all of these efforts in a mighty way.

Nov. 28 – We will not meet Dec. 1 - 2 Timothy

2 Timothy is the last letter from Paul in the New Testament. It was written from Paul's Roman prison cell just before he was executed for his faith in Christ by Emperor Nero (c. 67 AD.) He is in chains (2:9), in need of his cloak, scrolls & parchments (4:13), & is not hopeful about being released (4:6.) Many have abandoned him & others are away on mission. (1:15, 4:9-12, 16) Only Luke is with him. (4:11) Because he believes his time is short, he urges Timothy to get Mark & hurry to Rome for a final visit. (4:9, 11, 21) Paul writes, "For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time for my departure is near. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith." (4:6-7) As you would expect, 2 Timothy has a urgent, heartfelt and personal tone and is filled with encouragements and admonitions to persevere. The letter is about the need to keep guarding, suffering for, continuing in, and proclaiming the gospel. He tells Timothy that the time will come when people will not put up with sound doctrine, but will only listen to things they want to hear. And so he tells Timothy to "Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage with great patience and careful encouragement." (4:2) He reminds Timothy of the incredible power of the Scriptures - "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness." (3:16)


