WALKING THROUGH THE BIBLE

Resumes Next Wednesday, Dec. 2 * 6:00 pm Fellowship Hall

Join us as we walk through each book of the Bible. On December 2 we will study *1 Kings*. We are spreading out in the Fellowship Hall practicing social distancing. We are posting each study on our church YouTube channel. Take part in the study of God's word.

I Kings begins where 2 Samuel left off. It covers 118 years, beginning with the last days of King David (around 971 BC.) The first 11 chapters are about the reign of King Solomon and the building of the temple. After Solomon's reign the kingdom is divided into Israel (the northern 10 tribes) and Judah (the tribes of Judah and Benjamin.) We see the rapid decline of the two nations (especially Israel) as God's law is neglected and rebelled against. The history of 4 Kings of Judah are recorded (Rehoboam, Abijah, Asa and Jehoshaphat) and 8 Kings of Israel (Jeroboam, Nadab, Baasha, Elah, Zimri, Omri, Ahab and Ahaziah.) In the last part of 1 Kings we find the incredible stories of the prophet Elijah. The spectacular miracles God does through Elijah prepare us for the miracles and ministry of our Lord Jesus Christ.


