WALKING THROUGH THE BIBLE

Each Wednesday * 6:00 – 6:45 pm

Each week we will present an overview of a book of the Bible focusing on what that book teaches us about Jesus & our relationship with God. On Oct. 14 we will study *Judges* & on Oct. 21 – *Ruth*. Please join us for this powerful study. We are spreading out in the Fellowship Hall practicing social distancing. We are posting each study on our church YouTube channel.

Ruth

Ruth is a powerful love story that gives us a living example of how God brings good out of tragic circumstances. Ruth and her mother in law. Naomi. arrive in Bethlehem as widows - dependent on the generosity of others for survival. We learn how Ruth meets Boaz who becomes her "Kinsman Redeemer" and husband. The concept of a "Kinsman Redeemer" illustrates for us the relationship God has with Israel in the Old Testament as their "Redeemer" and the relationship Jesus offers to each person who will entrust themselves to Him in the New Testament. Ruth, a Moabitess, is King David's great-grandmother and is included by name in Matthew 1:5 in the genealogy of Christ. Ruth is also a story about the love, support, and faithfulness that can exist in family relationships. The most famous verse is Ruth 1:16 - a pledge that Ruth makes to Naomi - "Entreat me not to leave you, or to turn back from following after you; for wherever you go, I will go; and wherever you lodge, I will lodge; your people shall be my people, and your God, my God."


