GUEST TEACHERS – NOVEMBER 4

Rev. Richard McDowell will be our guest Wednesday Night Bible Study leader. Richard, like his dad George McDowell the pastor of Switzer First Baptist, came to the ministry later in life. After practicing law for a decade, he returned to seminary and joined his dad to form Agape Ministries which assists smaller churches to use technology to reach unchurched families. Richard was later called to Whitney First Baptist to help revive the church and served as its pastor until Covid-19 struck the church hard and forced it to close. Richard now works with his dad at Switzer assisting him in all facets of church ministry as he seeks the call of God to pastor another church.

WALKING THROUGH THE BIBLE

1 Samuel

1 Samuel tells us stories from the last days of the Judges - Eli and Samuel; stories about Israel's first King - Saul; and stories about David in the days before he becomes King. It covers a time period of a little less than 100 years, from around 1105 BC to 1011 BC. It contains the story of David and Goliath and many other famous stories. 1 Samuel and 2 Samuel were originally one book but were split into two books when the Hebrew Scriptures were translated into Greek in the third century BC. A famous verse from the story of the anointing of David tell us that "The LORD does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." 1 Samuel 16:7 We are given powerful insights into the inner workings of the hearts of Hannah, Samuel, Saul and David. We are able to observe Saul's mental illness and decline as well as the journey of David from obscure shepherd to national hero to the most wanted outlaw who later becomes king. A key term "The LORD's Anointed" will help prepare us for One from the line of David who will be called "The Christ" which means "The Anointed One."




