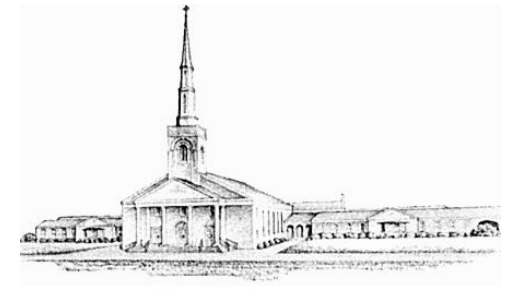

PRAYER AND BIBLE STUDY

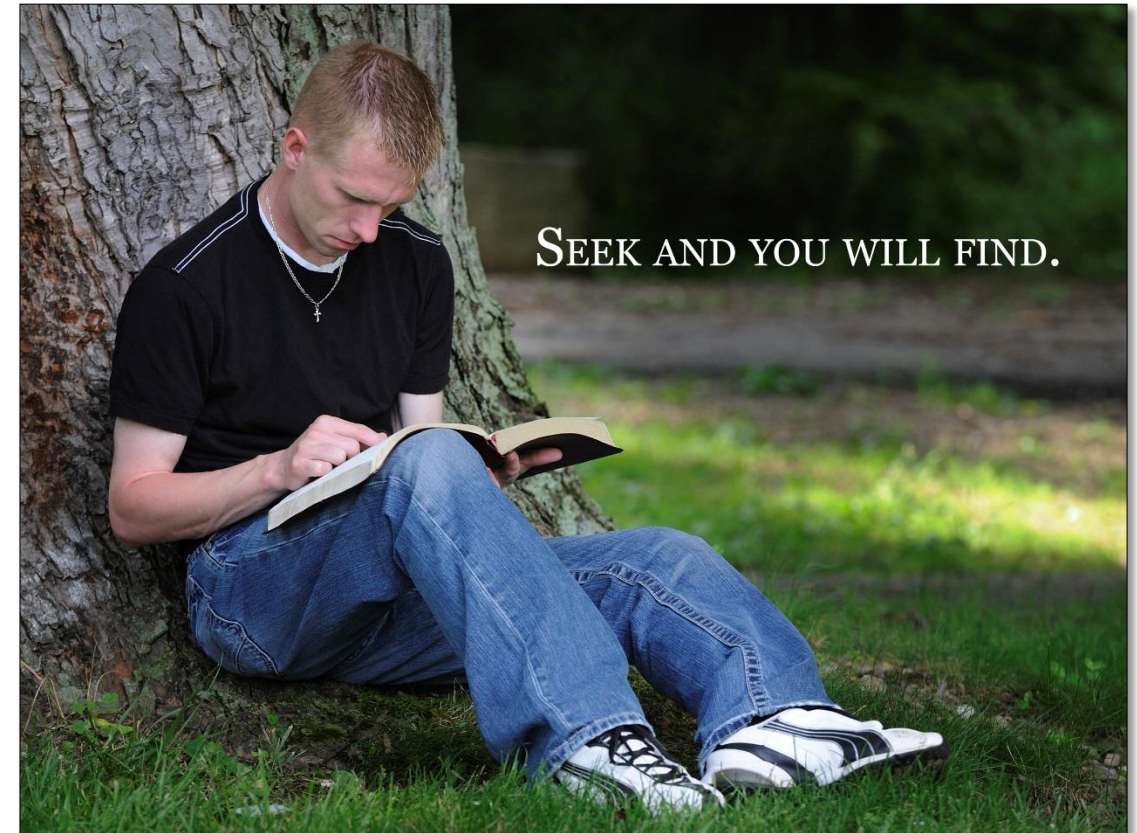
