Oct 6 – Ephesians **Oct 13 – Philippians**

Philippians is an incredible letter. Paul is in prison in Rome c. 62 AD. He is uncertain if he will be pardoned or executed, yet, the letter is filled with expressions of joy & contentment, relying on God regardless of the circumstances. The powerful account of the beginning of the Church at Philippi (recorded in Acts 16:11-40) includes the stories of Lydia's decision to trust Christ, Paul & Silas singing at midnight, and the salvation of the Philippian jailer & his family. Paul includes the text of an early hymn of the church (Philippians 2:6-11) to encourage believers to have the same mindset or attitude as Christ in their relationship with one another. The hymn tells the story of Jesus being equal with God yet not using equality with God to His own advantage but instead taking the nature of a servant who is obedient even to the point of death on a cross. The hymn ends with God exalting the name of Jesus to the highest place, **“that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in Heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”** In the Philippian letter Paul gives us the secret of being content in any circumstance.

- Be confident that God will finish the work He has started in you. (1:6)
- Realize that to live is Christ and to die is gain. (1:21)
- In humility, value others above yourself and put their needs before your own. (2:3-4)
- Strive for your attitude to be the same as Jesus'. (2:5)
- Do everything without grumbling, complaining or arguing. (2:14)
- Focus on knowing Christ & sharing in the fellowship of His suffering & in the power of His resurrection. (3:10)
- Forget what is behind and press on toward what is ahead. (3:13)
- Don't set your mind on earthly things but remember that your citizenship is in Heaven. (3:19-20)
- Don't worry about anything but pray about everything so that God's peace can guard both your heart and your mind. (4:6-7)
- Don't dwell on negative things but instead seek out and focus on those things that are true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent or praiseworthy. (4:8)
- Remember that Christ gives strength for any and every situation. (4:13)
- Trust that God is able to meet all of your needs through His riches in Christ Jesus. (4:19)

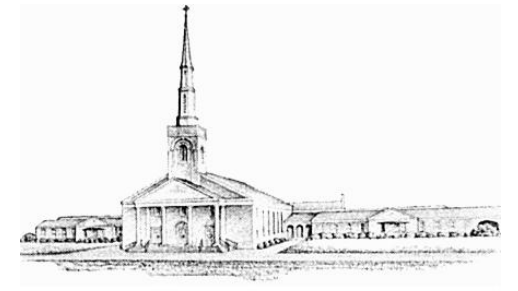
