October 18 - I STILL BELIEVE (rated PG, 1 hr 56 min.) The true-life story of Christian musician Jeremy Camp and his journey of love and loss that looks to prove there is always hope.

October 25 - OVERCOMER (rated PG, 1 hr 59 min.) High school basketball coach John Harrison and his team face an uncertain future when their town's largest manufacturing plant shuts down. As hundreds move away, John reluctantly agrees to coach cross-country, a sport he doesn't even like. His outlook soon changes when he meets Hannah Scott, an unlikely runner who pushes herself to the limit. (Overcomer is produced by the Kendrick Brothers who produced – Flywheel, Facing the Giants, Fireproof, Courageous, and War Room.)

WALKING THROUGH THE BIBLE

Each Wednesday * 6:00 - 6:45 pm

Each week we will present an overview of a book of the Bible focusing on what that book teaches us about Jesus & our relationship with God. On Oct. 7 we will study Joshua & on Oct. 14 - Judges. Please join us for this powerful study. We are spreading out in the Fellowship Hall practicing social distancing. We are posting each study on our church YouTube channel.

The stories in Judges take place after the people settle into the Promised Land and before the time of the kings. It was a time of moral relativism where "everyone did what was right in their own eyes" (Judges 17:6; 21:25) rather than following God's word. After the time of Joshua, "another generation grew up, who knew neither the LORD nor what He had done for Israel." (Judges 2:10) The stories in Judges go from bad to worse. There are a few moments of trust in God, but for the most part, Judges illustrates how bad things can get when people choose to compromise their faith and abandon God. A deteriorating cycle is presented and lived out in the stories...

- 1) The people reject God.
- 2) The people are in great distress.
- 3) God sends a deliverer.

This cycle repeats continually (7 times.) Some of the deliverers bring renewed faith in God for a season, others make choices that lead the people further away from God. We see how quick and how easy the human heart can be turned from God and how patient and persistent God is in His unceasing desire to bring repentance and restoration. Our society has too much in common with this biblical time period. Pray that the Lord would instill in us a spirit of faithfulness that would allow us to not miss the incredible things God will do when we choose loving obedience.






