Sept 22 – 2 Corinthians Sept 29 - Galatians Paul's letter to the Galatians is written to a group of churches. The Roman province of Galatia was located in what is now the nation of Turkey. Paul helped establish churches in Galatia (Pisidian Antioch, Iconium, Lystra, Derbe) during his first missionary journey (Acts 13-14) and returned to help strengthen the Galatian churches during his second missionary journey (Acts 16:1-6) and his third missionary journey (Acts 18:23.) The Galatian churches had come under the influence of people teaching the false doctrine that observing the Mosaic Law (including circumcision, dietary laws, and special days and seasons) was necessary for both Jewish and Gentile believers. Paul writes to help them understand the purpose of the laws of the Old Testament and how Jesus fulfills them. The laws show us our need for salvation. We are saved, not by keeping the law, but by God's grace. Paul will use the stories of Abraham and Sarah to illustrate how we are made right with God, not through the law, but through faith. A believer's life is not characterized by judgmental legalism but instead by the freedom that comes as we grow through the work of God's Holy Spirit to be people of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-discipline (Galatians 5:22-23.) You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love. For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." Galatians 5:13-14
