Sept 29 – Galatians **Oct 6** – Ephesians Paul wrote the letter to the Church at Ephesus from prison (Ephesians 3:1: 4:1: 6:20) most probably from Rome around 60-62 AD. (Philippians, Colossians, Philemon, and 2 Timothy were also written from prison.) Paul helped form the Church at Ephesus and served there for almost 3 years during his 3rd Missionary Journey (Acts 18:19 - 20:1.) Ephesians is short - only 155 verses (6 chapters) leading scholars to say that "Pound for pound, Ephesians may well be the most influential document in history." Ephesians deepens our understanding of the gospel and salvation; celebrates the incredible spiritual blessings we have in Christ; clearly communicates that we are saved by grace through faith; helps us to see the importance of the Church; emphasizes the unity that comes through Christ; gives practical instruction for marriage, parenting, vocation and living the Christian life; helps us become equipped for spiritual warfare; and contains beautiful prayers that glorify God and help us as we worship God. "Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the Church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen." Ephesians 3:20-21
