Joshua

- God keeps His promises. Many of God's promises to Abraham (in Genesis) and affirmed in the exodus journey find their fulfillment as God's people take possession of the Promised Land. Not one of all the Lord's good promises to Israel failed; everyone was fulfilled. Joshua 21:45
- We need to be strong & courageous. Regardless of the challenges or obstacles, God is worthy of our trust and our obedience. We do not need to be afraid if God is with us. He helps us take action to avoid the traps and snares that could bring us down.
- Sin effects everything. Even one person's sin has consequences for the entire community. It is foolish to think that the choices we make only effect us.
- God is able to accomplish what is impossible for us. When God is at work for us, the odds against us do not matter. If we try to do things in our own strength, we have already failed.
- Joshua demonstrates for us the power of a life lived with a consistent pattern of obedience. He left "nothing undone" that God had commanded. (Joshua 11:15) His example inspired and led the way for the faithfulness of others, "As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD." Joshua 24:15 The generations influenced by Joshua were drastically different from the generations (described in Judges) that followed.
- Joshua's name means "Yahweh Saves" or "Salvation is from the LORD." The name "Jesus" is the Greek form of the Hebrew name "Joshua." The angel told Joseph, "You are to give Him the name Jesus, because He will save His people from their sins." Matthew 1:21

LIONS CLUB "CRUISE IN" Saturday, October 10 * 10:00 am - 2:00 pm **First Baptist Church Parking Lot**


